Kids really loved watching a loud group of big motorcycles passing by....





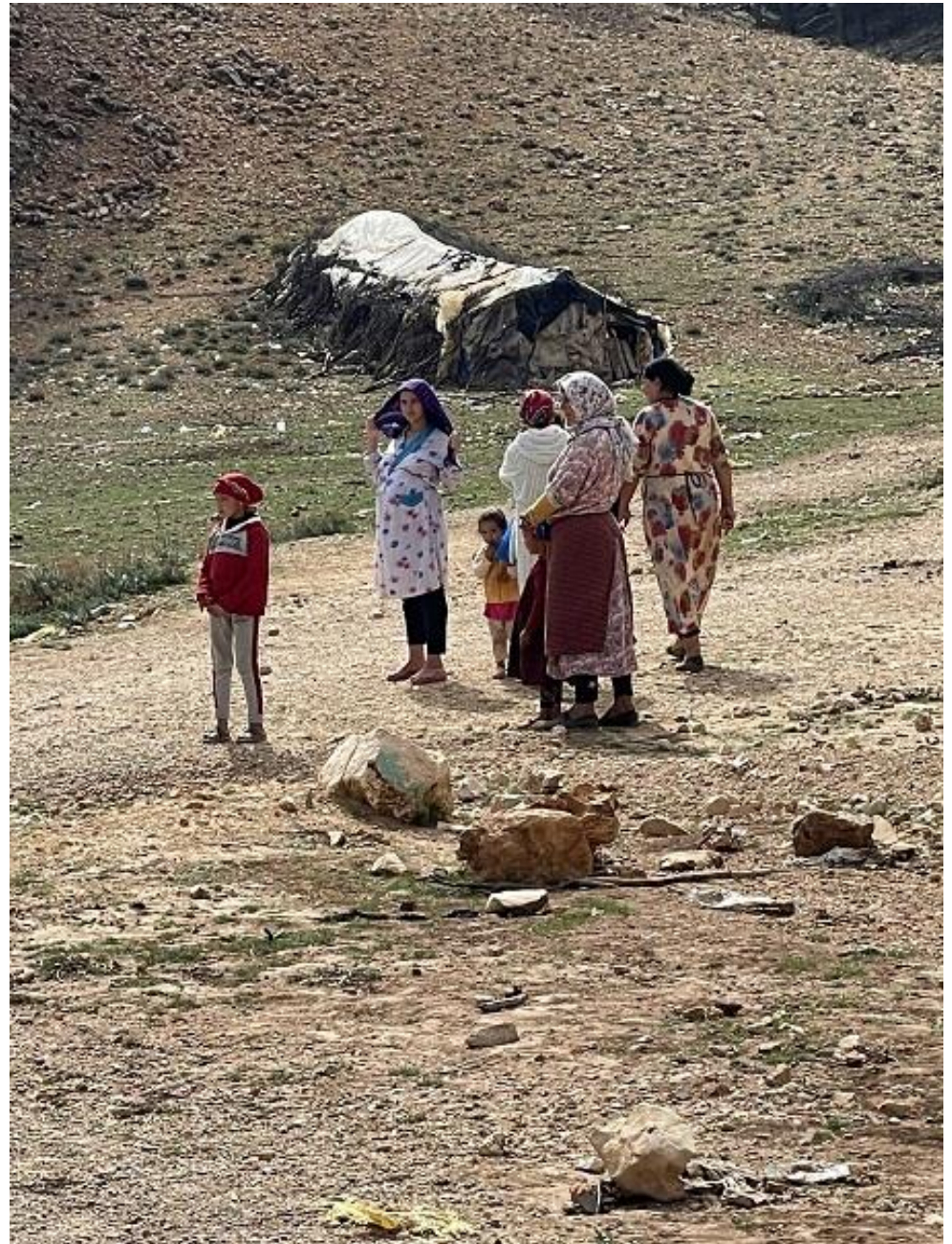
...and we loved this boy who was wearing his older brother's flip-flops....



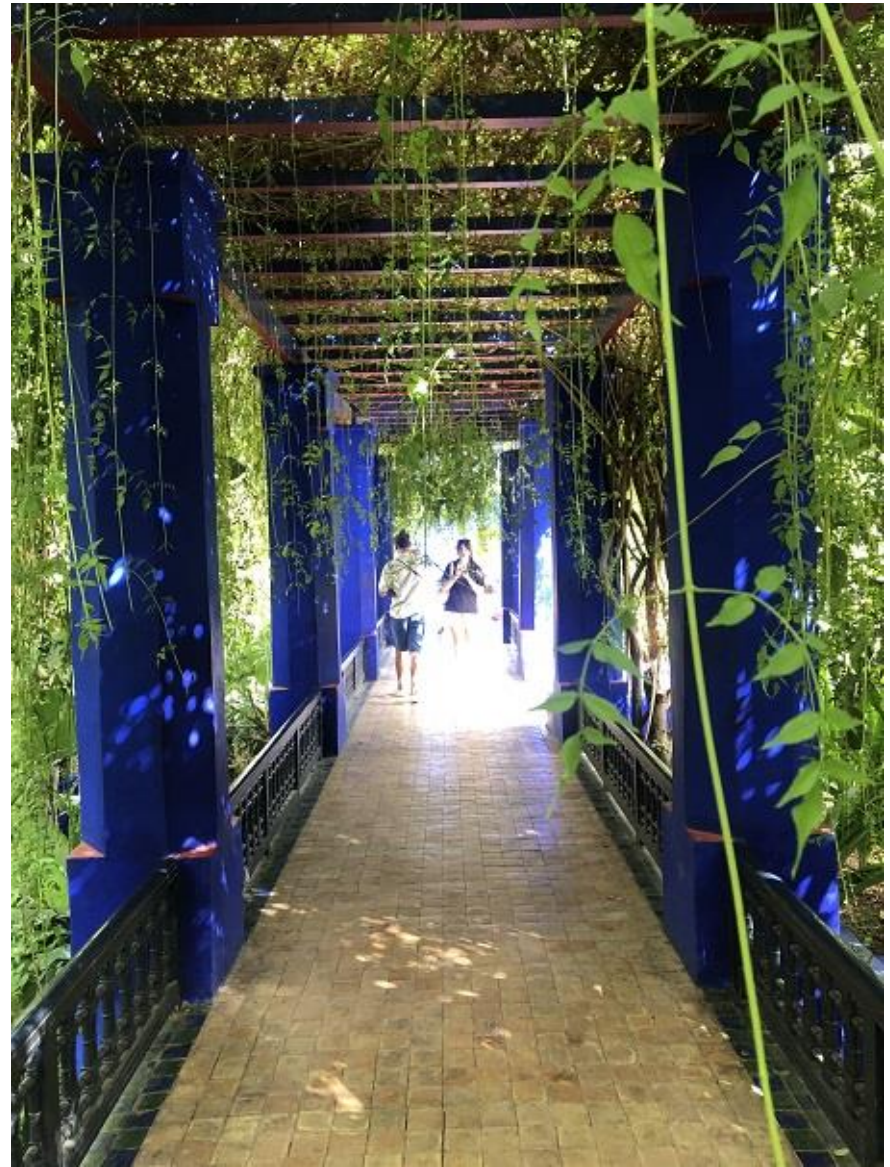
Luxurious homes (because they have electricity)

(any American cop would get about three heart attacks per day over there)









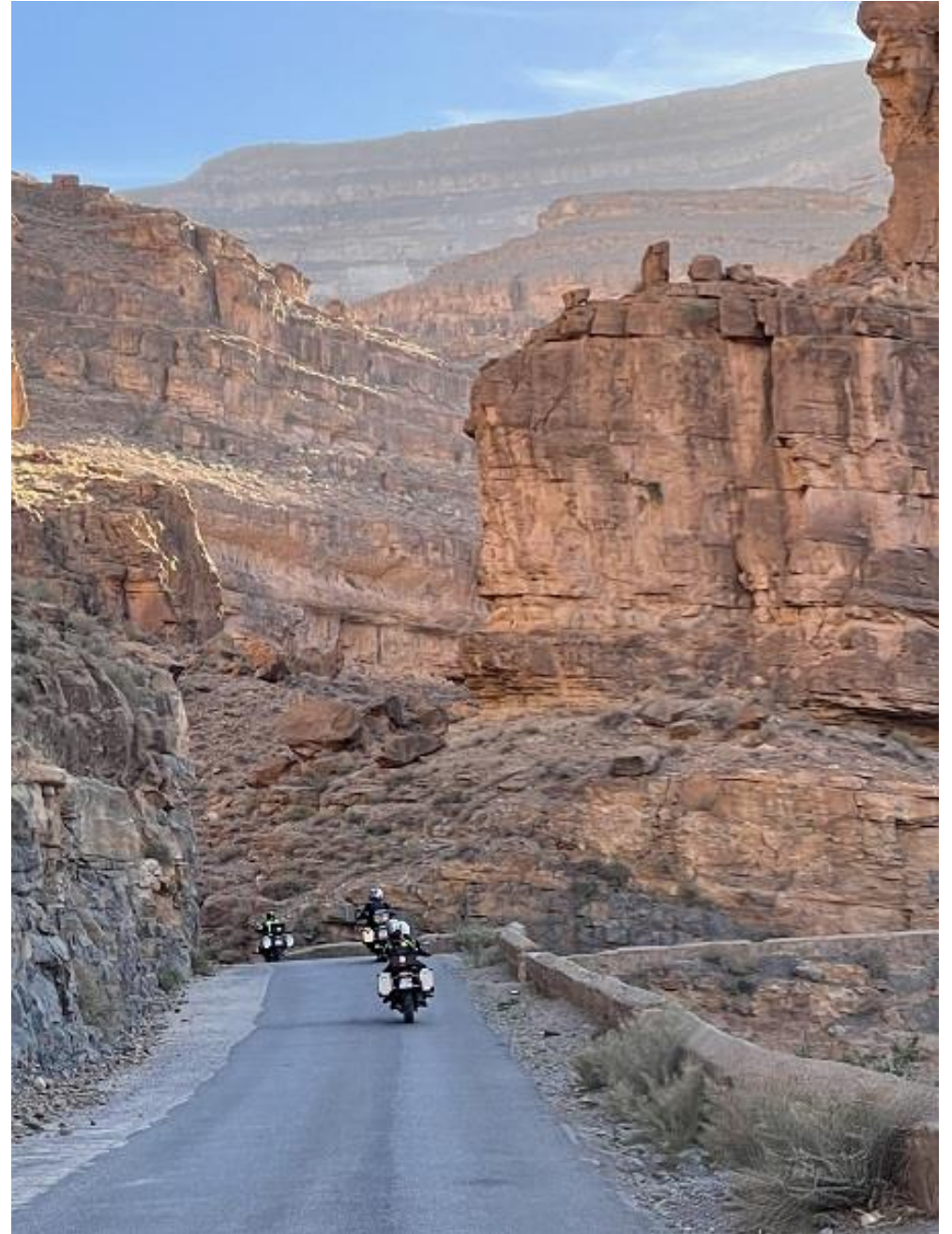
